

TRAVEL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CCAT HALTON

Introduction.

1. The Cadet Centre for Adventurous Training (CCAT), Halton is situated in Halton Training Camp, near Lancaster on the River Lune. The Camp is administered by the Defence Training Estates (North-West).

Location and Address.

2. The Camp is situated a mile west of Halton Village, and can be reached from junction 34 on the M6.

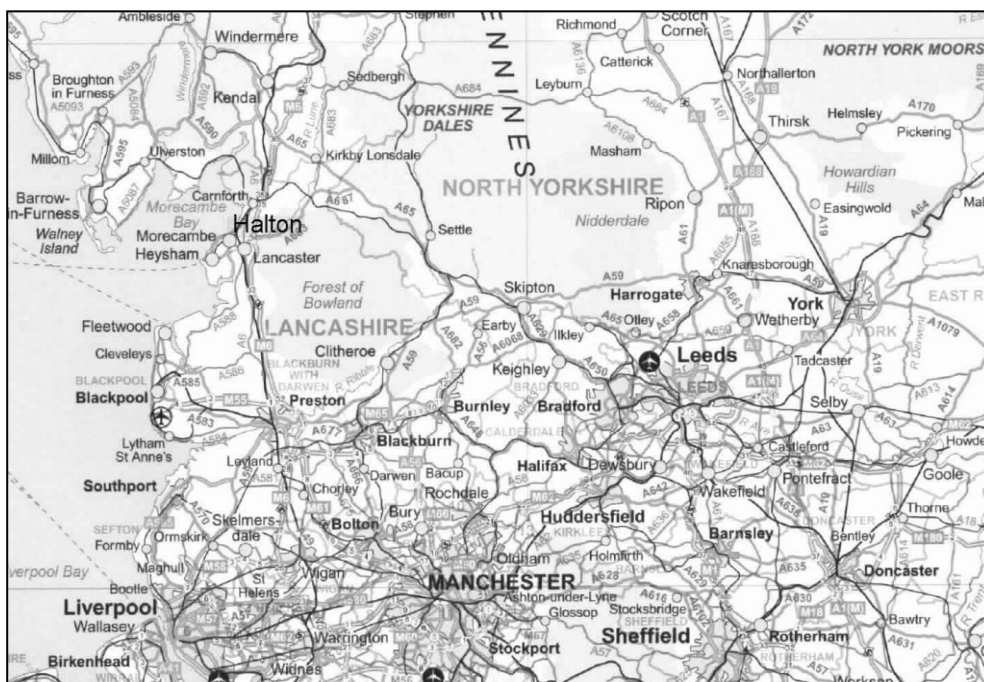

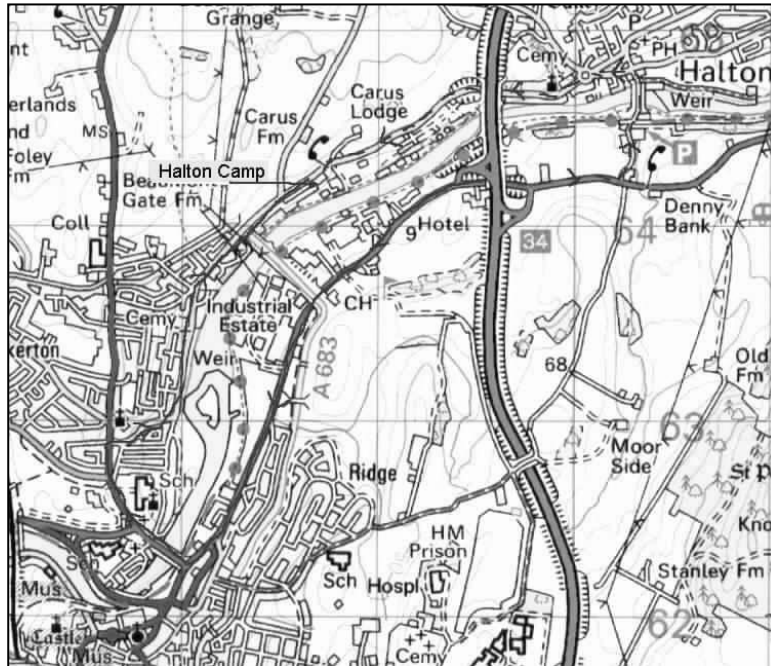

Location

5. Halton Camp lies just off the M6 motorway near Junction 34, the Lancaster exit. The camp is signposted from the motorway slip road.

By road:

6. Leave the M6 motorway at Junction 34. At the traffic lights at the end of the slip road turn right and follow the signs for Halton Training Camp.

a. Sat nav users should use post code LA2 6LW

By train:

7. Lancaster is on the West Coast Main Line, with regular services from London, Birmingham and Glasgow. There are also local trains from the East Coast Main Line at York. www.thetrainline.com gives details of train times.

8. A pick-up will be arranged to meet the 1600-1730 train on Sunday and by prior arrangement on Friday for weekend courses.

9. Personnel who do not arrive by these times will be required to make their own arrangements from Lancaster train station to Halton Training Camp.

10. The train station is a minimum of 40 minutes from the camp and this should be taken into consideration when booking homeward travel.
